Fluorescence Guided Surgery is an exciting new technology that allows surgeons to see the invisible during open and laparoscopic surgery.

Visualization of the biliary anatomy during cholecystectomy, confirming the bowel perfusion prior to the anastomosis and identifying the lymphatic drainage of tumors, are only several of many possible applications of fluorescence enhanced surgery.

The aim of this course, which is under the patronage of the Italian Society of Minimally Invasive Surgery (S.I.C.E.), is to demonstrate during live surgical procedures, the main clinical applications of fluorescence guided surgery as well as to present the potential of this technology in different fields of surgery. The course is open to consultants, residents, anesthetists and scrub nurses.
